3 Keys to Unlocking Miracles

- Miracles are not accidents; they are Heaven's response to faith and alignment with God.
- Jesus performed miracles to demonstrate His love, His nature, so we can know Him (its relational), then also to reveal God's Kingdom and third to confirm His Word.
- Today, we'll unlock 3 biblical keys that position us to experience the miraculous.

Introduction

Miracles are not accidents; they are Heaven's response to faith and alignment with God. This is what I know: *Miracles are not random accidents*. They are not reserved for the "super-spiritual" or the elite. Miracles are God's response to those who position themselves in alignment with God.

Jesus performs miracles to demonstrate His love, and His nature so we can know Him (its relational). Likewise, when Jesus performs miracles to demonstrate the Kingdom of God and confirm His Word, He does so with the purpose of revealing Himself. And the good news is this — the same God who worked miracles then is still working miracles today!

But the question we must ask ourselves is: *How do we unlock the miraculous in our lives?* Today, I want to give you **3 keys to unlocking miracles**. And as you put them into practice, I believe you will step into a lifestyle where Heaven invades Earth, and impossibilities somehow become possible!

Key 1: The Key of Expectation

Scripture: *"The expectation of the righteous will not be cut off."* (Proverbs 23:18)

Expectation is the seedbed of miracles. Wherever there is expectation, there is room for God to move. Expectancy creates the atmosphere for miracles. Hope opens the door; expectation pulls the miracle into reality.

In my miracle meetings, I am always very intentional to stir up Faith Expectation and Hope and what I know is this, when I do it, miracles happen.

As you see it, that's how it comes to you.

Woman with the issue of blood. Mark 5:28 – “If I can just touch His robe, I will be healed.”

Expectation activated faith—and healing followed.

Think of the lame man in Acts 3, who sat at the temple gate. The Bible says, “*When he saw Peter and John about to enter, he asked them for money. Peter looked straight at him...and said, ‘Look at us!’ So the man gave them his attention, **expecting** to receive something from them.*” And what happened? Peter lifted him up in the name of Jesus and the man walked for the first time in his life.

Expectation creates the environment for miracles. Hope opens the door, but expectation pulls the miracle into reality. If you don't expect God to move, you won't even recognize it when He does.

Illustration: Imagine a farmer who plants seed but never expects a harvest. He would never water it, never tend to it, never prepare his barn. Expectation is what gets you ready for what God has promised.

Miracle Activation #1: Close your eyes right now. Picture the miracle you need from God. See it clearly in your spirit—healing, breakthrough, provision, deliverance. Now lift your hands and begin to thank Him in advance, saying: “*Lord, I EXPECT my miracle today!*”

Key 2: Faith Conditions (Obedience is Key)

Scriptures:

“*Whatever He says to you, do it.*” (John 2:5)

“Where the word of a king is, there is power...” (Ecclesiastes 8:4)

Miracles are often released at the intersection of God's instruction and your obedience.

At the wedding in Cana, when the wine ran out, Mary told the servants: “*Whatever He says to you, do it.*” Jesus then instructed them to fill the waterpots with water. It made no sense. But as they obeyed, water was turned into wine.

Naaman, the Syrian commander, came to Elisha for healing from leprosy. He was told to dip in the Jordan River seven times. At first, he was offended by the simplicity of the command. But when he obeyed, his skin was restored like that of a child.

Obedience is not about understanding everything; it's about trusting the One who gives the instruction. Many miss their miracle because they argue with the instruction. In reality, they reject the package. Even delayed obedience is still disobedience.

Illustration: Think of a keycard for a hotel room. The door won't open until you activate it by sliding it exactly as instructed. Obedience is sliding the key God's way.

Prophetic Activation #2: Right now, ask the Holy Spirit, *"What is one thing You are asking me to obey today?"* It may be forgiving someone, stepping out in generosity, or when the moment for your miracle arrives, obey the activation instructions. Commit in your heart to act on it. Say aloud: *"Lord, I will do whatever You say."*

Key 3: The Key of Faith

Scripture: *"According to your faith let it be done to you."* (Matthew 9:29)

Faith is Heaven's currency. Faith is what moves the impossible into the possible. Jesus never said, *"According to your feelings,"* or *"According to your wishes."* He said, *"According to your faith."*

The woman with the issue of blood is a perfect example. She said within herself, *"If I only touch the hem of His garment, I will be healed."* And when she reached out in faith, instantly the power of God flowed, and her miracle came.

Faith is not just believing that God can — it is believing that God will. It is leaning your full weight on His Word.

Illustration: Imagine sitting on a chair. You don't test it halfway; you put your full weight on it. That is what faith looks like — resting fully on God's promises.

Faith connects you directly to the miracle-working power of God. When faith is present, the supernatural overtakes the natural.

Faith is not a matter of size, because if it was, faith would be transactional.

Faith is actually a supernatural connection with God, which is relational.

Example: Jesus Heals Ten Men With Leprosy

Luke 17:11-19

¹¹Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. ¹²As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy^[a] met him. They stood at a distance ¹³and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!"

¹⁴When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed.

¹⁵ One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. ¹⁶ He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.

¹⁷ Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine?" ¹⁸ Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?" ¹⁹ Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."

Prophetic Activation #3: Lay your hand on your heart and declare with me: *"I believe God. I receive by faith. Nothing is impossible for my God!"*

Conclusion

So, what are the 3 keys to unlocking miracles?

1. **Expectation** — Believe that God will move.
2. **Obedience** — Do whatever He says.
3. **Faith** — Connect with God, plug in to Him and trust

When you put these 3 keys together, you position yourself for the supernatural. The atmosphere of expectation, the posture of obedience, and the action of faith open the door wide for Heaven to invade Earth.

And I prophesy over you today: this is a season of miracles. What was impossible yesterday becomes possible today because the God of miracles is with you!
